Open House to Discuss New Coastal Flood Maps

Flooding is the number one natural disaster in the United States; it is vital for property owners to understand their risk, and take advantage of tools and programs available to them, including flood insurance, to help reduce flooding impacts. FIRMs provide the basis for flood risk education and floodplain management measures. The City is required to adopt updated maps to continue participating in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP), which makes flood insurance available to the community.

Some buildings in the City may be included in a high-risk flood zone due to the changes, and this may result in mandatory purchase of flood insurance for those property owners who are affected.

The City will hold a public Coastal Flood Risk Open House on the updates at The Pavilion at Bide-A-Wee (1 Bide-A-Wee Drive) on Wednesday, July 9th from 4:30pm-7:30pm.

Representatives from the State, the City, and FEMA, will be available to answer flood risk and insurance questions, and explain the preliminary maps.
