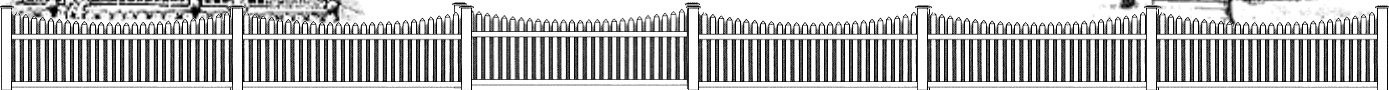

PORT NORFOLK CIVIC LEAGUE SPECIAL MEETING ANNOUNCEMENT

September 2, 2010

Port Norfolk Recreation Center

In attendance: members of the Portsmouth City Council and a Representative from Hull's Creek Properties.

Topic of discussion: the Memorandum of Intent between the City and Hulls' Creek Properties for the Sale and the proposed residential development plan of the former Port Norfolk Elementary School site. The proposal would call for the development of 40 Single Family Homes in the price range of mid \$200,000.

The Port Norfolk Civic League along with Lake Shores Civic League are opposed to the development, our concerns water drainage (the school site is in a floodplain area), rezoning of the area changing the property value, and environmental issues to name a few.


